The L2 Award Preparation to Work in Community Interpreting

Suitable for students who wish to gain knowledge and skills of community interpreting, including the role of codes of practice and learn about the settings where interpreters may be required to work.

L1 Award Mental Health Awareness & L1 Award Stress Awareness

These units support learners to gain a wider knowledge of the mental health issues that can impact on people's lives and explore the common misconceptions of mental health difficulties and how stress affects our lives.
